- When have you experienced restoration? What was lost and needing to be restored? How did this help fuel growth and stability?
- Reread Joel 3:4-5. Explore the differences between ideas such as karma, vengeance, and retribution. What difference does it make for you and your faith, knowing that God actively confronted and corrected the oppressors?
- What patterns, practices, promotions might make our faith community appear "unsafe" for others? How might we start to shift that perspective?
- Where might God want to use you as a "Defender". Who would benefit from your action on their behalf?
