Questions to guide your discussion; As time allows, welcome general converation about the sermon

- Around the Circle: A question to get everyone talking and involved
- Try to remember an awkward situation that you experienced in life. If you choose, feel free to share it. If it's hard to share, consider offering why it's difficult.
- Select Few: A question for a few group members to offer personal experience or vulnerable insights.
- Identify a moment in your life where it has been easier to protect ME instead of investing in WE. What did you need in order to make the move away from ME and towards WE?
- Read Colossians 3:5-9 recalling that our life with Christ calls for the death of one type of life and the renewal of another.
 From the list that Paul provides, what sort of things still need to die in your own life?
- Continue reading Colossians 3:12-15, noting the characteristics of a resurrected life. Where do you see your greatest opportunity for spiritual growth represented in the list that Paul provides here?
- Pastor Sam reminds us that mutual submission is the choice to leverage your <u>power</u>, <u>assets</u>, and <u>time</u> for the benefit of someone else. Which of these is God asking you to leverage during this season of your life? And who is the someone else that God is asking you to submit to?
- Dig Deep: A question that may/may not be answered in session, but should be encouraged for people to wrestle with all week.
- Who in your life is waiting to hear the words, "What can I do to help?" What's made it hard for you to say those words? How can you change that this week?
