Conversation Guidelines



Questions to guide your discussion; as time allows, general conversation about the sermon is welcomed

Around the Circle: A question to get everyone talking and involved

• Share a time when you've had a hallucination or a vision of something that either wasn't there, or other people couldn't see. How did you feel when you realized it wasn't there?

Select Few: Questions designed for a few group members to offer personal experience or vulnerable insights.

- The people at the procession into the city were focused on the hallel (praise psalms from Ps. 113-118) in this season of Passover. What scriptures would you proclaim if Jesus were to be sitting before you today, and why?
- Greco Roman processions had 4 elements that made them "official."- Followers, words of praise, symbols of authority and powerful actions. What do you require of someone in order to allow them to have leadership and influence in your life?
- Disappointment has the potential to destroy us, or to drive us. How does a relationship with Jesus help build our resilience when we are in the wilderness?

Dig Deep: A question that may or may not be answered in session, but should be encouraged for members to wrestle with all week.

• Jesus lamented and wept over the city of Jerusalem more than once. When is the last time you wept (or were emotionally moved) on behalf of someone else who was in a wilderness? How might you be an answer to their prayers?
