Discussion Questions

- Think back over the past 30 years of your life. What is an overarching hope that you have longed for? What has been the noisiest noise you've have had to live with?
- In the story, Elizabeth says that God "took away the disgrace." (Lk. 1:25) How has your connection to God, church, or people of faith helped provide healing for you?
- Luke 1:44 Is where we God reveals himself to Elizabeth and (a child within her leaps); there is joy. How might God speak or act in a way that would cause you to jump for joy?
- Elizabeth and Mary are connected, both because they are relatives and because of the invitation to become a part of God's activity in the world. Who might God be inviting you to be in relationship within this season of life? What difference would it make for you to join others in a mission to invite all people into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ? (See Lk. 1:41-42)
- Share with someone else: What is the life that you long to live? How does it compare the life God intends for his followers?
- Celebrate: How has the hope of God turned noisy nose into joyful noise in recent months?
