Discussion Questions:

*as time allows, general conversation about
the sermon is welcomed*

Around the Circle: *A question to get everyone
talking and involved*

- Name a time in your life when you were *overly optimistic* about a situation that you were facing. What work did you have to put in to the backside of that opportunity?

Select Few: *Questions designed for a few
group members to offer personal experience
or vulnerable insights.*

- Given your own background and reading of scripture, what has been your understanding of the resurrection in relationship to time? Is it a 'whenever you die' event, an 'end times event, or a 'here and now' event?
- Discuss a time where you have felt most dishonored, humiliated, or degraded. How did you want to respond after experiencing this type of humiliation?
- Name a time when you have stripped someone else of their dignity and dishonored them. How have you worked to reconcile that relationship?
- When we take on the resurrected life, we talk on God's life... the glorified life. This life reshapes our actions in relation to other people. **Where have you seen God's life create the most change in your life and actions? Where are their opportunities for growth?**

Dig Deep: *A question that may or may not be
answered in session, but should be
encouraged for members to wrestle with all
week.*

- **Who is the person who had most humiliated you, that you need to pay a visit to and build them up?**
